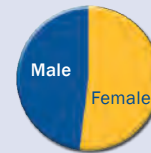
With its home campus in St. Louis, Webster University is a worldwide institution committed to delivering high-quality learning experiences that transform students for global citizenship and individual excellence. Founded in 1915, Webster offers undergraduate, graduate, and MBA degree programs, as well as a global network of more than 100 campuses in 7 countries (Austria, China, Switzerland, Thailand, The Netherlands, United Kingdom, United States). Its 20,000-plus student population represents almost 150 nationalities. The University's core values include excellence in teaching, joining theory and practice, small class sizes, and educating students to be lifelong independent learners, prepared to participate in an increasingly international society.

The modern Vienna campus is situated on the banks of the Danube River and the beautiful Danube Island recreation area. From the city center the campus is only 20 minutes by public transportation. Webster students and faculty also publish Vienna's major English language newspaper "The Vienna Review."

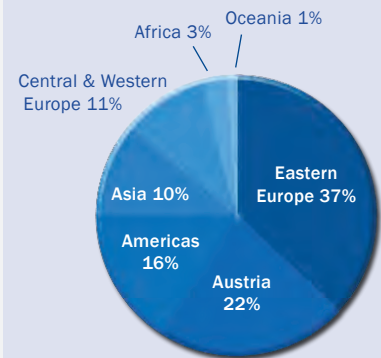

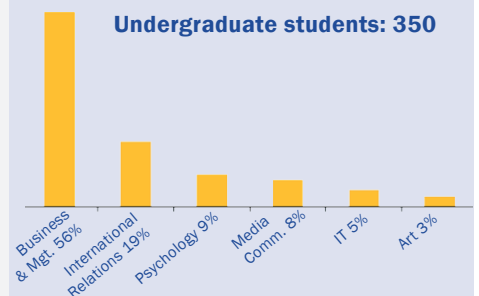

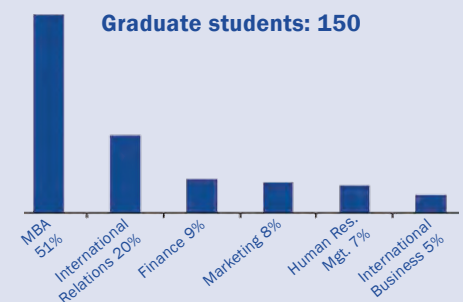

Webster University, Vienna is the only university in Austria with dual accreditation, American and Austrian.

- Webster University is accredited **in the United States by the Higher Learning Commission.**
- Webster University Vienna is accredited **by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Science and Research** (bm:wf) as an Austrian private university.

- It is a vibrant city with an international population of 1.7 million people.
- Vienna, Europe’s Music capital, is safe and clean with centuries of history, imperial buildings, museums, theatres, cultural festivals, and of course the famous Viennese coffee houses.
- The city has an excellent infrastructure and public transportation.
- 50% of the city is “green” with numerous parks, long bike paths, swimming and sailing opportunities on the Alte Donau (only 5 min. from Webster).
- Vienna is the home of many multinational headquarters for the CEE region and international organizations with interesting internship and employment opportunities, like the United Nations, OSCE, OPEC, etc.
- Vienna is in the heart of Europe with easy access to many major European cities and historical sites.

- 1986** – London campus is established
- 1996** – opens first Asian campus in Shanghai
- 1996** – Webster Vienna grows and moves to new premises in the 22nd District, close to the UN
- 1999** – Thailand campus is established
- 2001** – Webster Vienna receives the Austrian private university accreditation
- 2007** – starts Global programs in International Relations and MBA
- 2011** – 30th Anniversary in Vienna

Admissions Requirements

- Submit online application including Euro 40 application fee
- Two letters of recommendation
- 400 word motivational essay
- Copy of the biographical page of your passport
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae

Undergraduate:

- Min. TOEFL: PTB 490, IBT 57 (or IELTS 5.5)
- Official certified English translations of: last 3 years of transcripts incl. graduation date (min. GPA of 2.5 or equivalent)
- Considered for Advanced Standing: AP, IB, A-Levels, Italian Matura, German Abitur, Austrian Matura, Spanish Cou, Swiss Maturite, Norwegian Vitnemal, Netherlands VWO, European and French Bac
- ACT or SAT preferred but not required

Graduate:

- Min. TOEFL PBT 575, IBT 89 (or IELTS 7)
 - Official certified English translations of all university transcripts incl. graduation date
 - For MBA students, a minimum of two years work experience is preferred
 - GMAT or equivalent
- Application deadlines are rolling and vary by term. Please check: www.webster.ac.at*

An acceptance package including a visa application will be sent to accepted students. Visas may take up to 6 months.
